Situation

Broughton Astley is situated in an elevated south facing position and set well back from the road, on the south west side of Lewes. The property is within easy distance of the town centre and close to the mainline railway station with its regular service to London (London Victoria/London Bridge in about 64 minutes).

Lewes is situated within the South Downs National Park and has a wide range of shops, cafes and restaurants, together with several supermarkets. The city of Brighton and Hove is about 8 miles to the south west and provides a comprehensive range of cultural and shopping facilities.

The South Downs National Park provides wonderful opportunities for walking and

recreation. The port of Newhaven, some 6.5 miles to the south, has a ferry service to Dieppe. The internationally renowned Glyndebourne Opera House is about 4.5 miles to the east.

The Property

This detached early Edwardian house, built circa 1904, offers spacious and well-proportioned accommodation, with excellent natural light, and is arranged over three floors. From many of the rooms, particularly on the upper floors, there are wonderful far reaching views to the South Downs. The house offers numerous period features including many period fireplaces, high ceilings, sash windows, panelled doors and some large bay windows.

Of particular note is the spacious dual aspect drawing room which has a fireplace inset with a wood burning stove and a half glazed door to the garden. The kitchen and breakfast room have a tiled floor and the breakfast room has an Aga and double doors leading to a sheltered paved sitting area to the west side of the house. The dining room has a period fireplace and a south facing bay window. The principal bedroom is situated on the first floor and has a double aspect and an ensuite shower room. Over the first and second floors, there are 6 further good sized bedrooms, one of which is currently being used as a study, some with built in cupboards and there is a bathroom on each floor.

Broughton Astley is approached from Kingston Road via a shared drive which leads to the property's gravel parking area, adjacent to the house and the garage. From the parking area steps lead up to the front door. To one side of the parking area is an area of lawn with a mature mulberry tree and yew tree to one side. The principal gardens lie to the east and north of the house and benefit from some stunning far reaching views to the Ouse Valley and the South Downs. The garden is mainly laid to lawn and consists of a gentle south facing slope interspersed with some fruit trees. To the south side of the garden is a flat area of lawn adjacent to the east side of the house and accessed from the drawing room.

Directions

From Lewes Railway station proceed along Station Road in a southerly direction and at the mini roundabout, turn right along Priory Road. At the next mini roundabout, proceed straight across into Southover High Street. Continue along Southover High Street passing the church of St John the Baptist on the left and Anne of Cleeves House on the right. At the next mini roundabout proceed straight over (signed Kingston and Newhaven) and continue along the Kingston Road for 0.5 mile, passing the Lewes Rugby ground on the left.

As the road bends to the right the shared driveway to Broughton Astley will be seen on the right. After turning into the driveway, Broughton Astley is at the top of the incline just before the drive bends to the right.
