LOCAL AUTHORITY	CURRENT POSITION
Breckland	 The Breckland Local Plan was adopted 28th November 2019. There is currently no commencement date for the next 'Call for Sites'.
Broadland	 The current Local Development Plan is the Joint Core Strategy DPD (for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk) adopted in 2011; a series of amendments were adopted in January 2014. The emerging Greater Norwich Local Plan Regulation 18 Draft Plan Consultation was undertaken from 29 January 2020 - 16 March 2020. Adopted is currently scheduled for September 2021.
Great Yarmouth	 The Local Plan Part 1 (Core Strategy) was adopted by Full Council on 21 December 2015. The Local Plan Part 2 - Final Draft Plan is currently open for public consultation and representations are being sought between Friday 28 February and Friday 22 May 2020. This Draft Local Plan Part 2 is then anticipated to be submitted to the Secretary of State in the late Spring of 2020. The expected adoption for this document is December 2020. The New Local Plan (2021-2041) is expected to carry out the 'Call for Sites' in Autumn 2021. The expected adoption date for the emerging Local Plan is Autumn/Winter 2023.
King's Lynn & West Norfolk	 The Core Strategy is a document, which forms one part of the Local Development Framework, was adopted in 2011. Currently under Local Plan review up to 2036. The draft Local Plan review was published for an eight-week consultation period from the 4 March to the 29 April 2019. The Local Plan review is due to be adopted in the Spring months of 2021. However, the Local Development Scheme is currently being revised in light of COVIDevid-19 circumstances.
North Norfolk	 The current Local Plan comprises the Core Strategy & Development Management Policies. The Council produced its First Draft Local Plan Part 1 consultation in May/June 2019. The First Draft Local Plan (Part 2) consultation date is to be confirmed. Currently seeking approval through Cabinet regarding the revised timetable for Local Plan production, which has been revised for reasons other than COVID-19. At present, the estimation is that Regulation 19 publication on the Local Plan will take place June/July 2020 with Submission in September 2021.
Norwich	 The current Local Development Plan is the Joint Core Strategy DPD (for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk) adopted in 2011; a series of amendments were adopted in January 2014. The emerging Greater Norwich Local Plan Regulation 18 Draft Plan Consultation was undertaken from 29 January 2020 - 16 March 2020. Adopted is currently scheduled for September 2021.
