The Property

Old Blackhouse cottage is set in a truly remote position on the western side of the beautiful Isle of North Uist in the Outer Hebrides. The property presents an exceptional opportunity to create a distinctive holiday let or a comfortable family home in a stunning coastal setting, beside the sheltered waters of Bäl a' Chaolais bay.

Internally the cottage accommodation is across a single level, comprising a sitting room with a traditional fireplace, a kitchen, one bedroom, and a bathroom. There is significant scope for redevelopment: the existing footprint could be modernised to create a cosy, characterful retreat, or, subject to the necessary consents, the property could be extended to form a larger, more versatile residence. This combination of location, charm, and potential makes Old Blackhouse an ideal project for those seeking a unique island retreat or holiday escape on the rugged Outer Hebrides.

Outside

The cottage sits within a fenced plot, surrounded by open land, with views across the water and just a few yards from Bayhead's primary school and village shop. Its elevated south-east facing position allows sweeping vistas across the bay and surrounding hills, combining a sense of seclusion with convenient access to the village's amenities.



Location

Bayhead is a small settlement on the Isle of North Uist offering day-to-day amenities including a village shop with Post Office and petrol station. The local primary school, Sgoil Uibhist a Tuath, provides Gaelic-medium education for children from nursery through to the end of primary years. The area is renowned for its unspoiled landscapes, coastal walks, and abundant wildlife, offering a sense of tranquillity rarely found elsewhere. Bayhead is served by the main A865 road and local bus services, with ferry connections from Lochmaddy to the mainland and inter-island routes providing wider transport links.



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

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
