A handsome Grade II listed period house with a wealth of characterful accommodation, a self-contained annexe, stabling and extensive grounds, in a picturesque Wiltshire setting

The Old Rectory is an impressive country house, extending to over 4,500 sq ft of characterful accommodation, set within a peaceful and idyllic location approximately four miles south of Warminster. Dating from the 17th century and substantially rebuilt in the mid-19th century, the property displays handsome stone elevations, while the interior retains a wealth of period features, including sash windows, original fireplaces and fine detailing throughout.

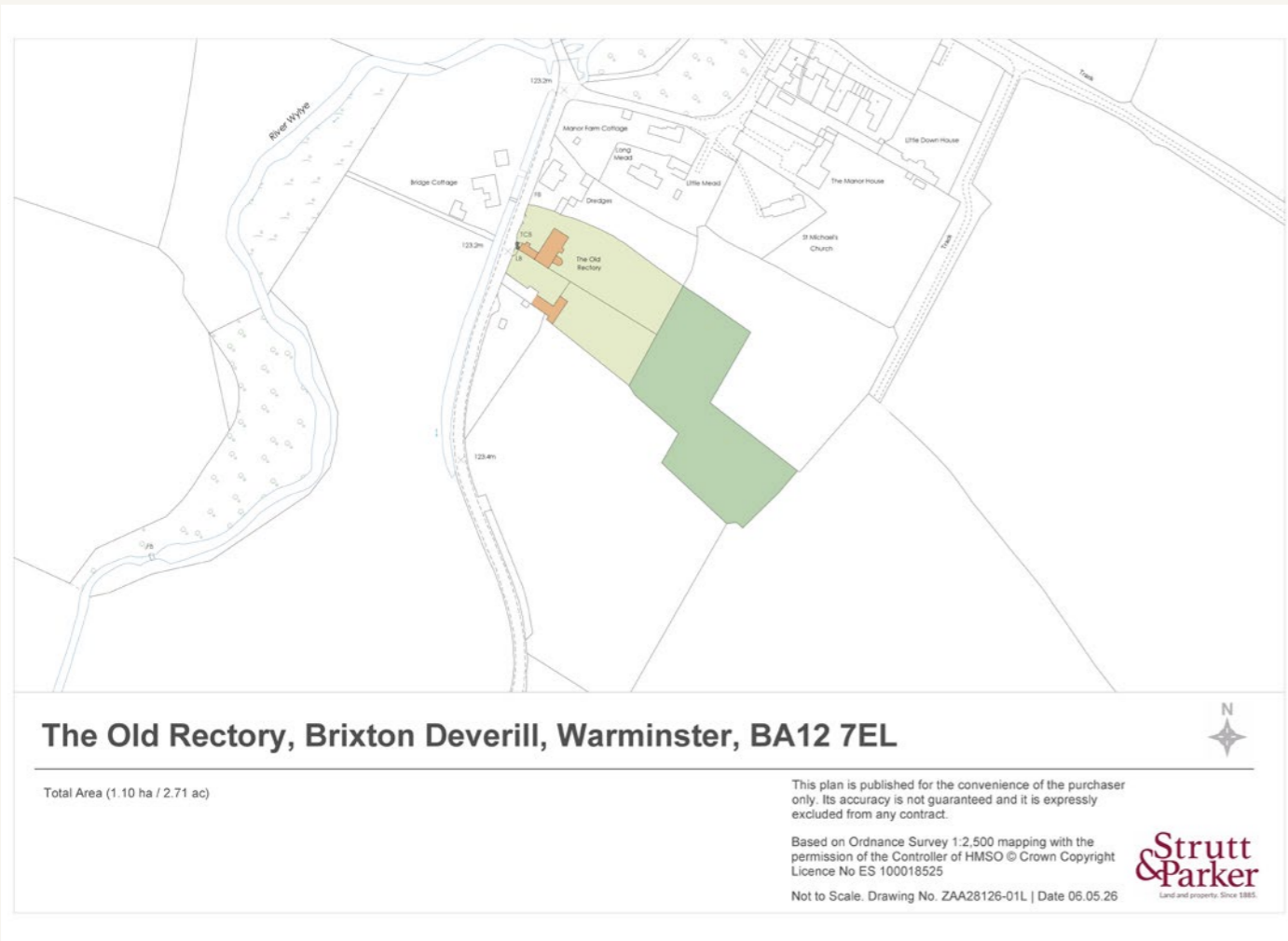
The ground floor is centred around a welcoming entrance hall with mosaic tiled flooring, leading to four principal reception rooms. These comprise a comfortable sitting room with fireplace and bay window overlooking the front gardens, a formal dining room, a study ideal for home working, and a playroom. The playroom opens via double doors to a bright conservatory with panoramic glazing and French doors to the gardens. The kitchen, designed and made by David Craigie, is well-appointed with modern units and integrated appliances, complemented by a boot room and utility room. In addition, there is an attached self-contained annexe, which was the original 'school room', providing a kitchen, a generous studio-style bedroom and sitting area with arched leaded windows and vaulted ceiling, and a shower room. This space has also been used for parties and it could also be a studio space.

On the first floor, the main house offers four well-proportioned double bedrooms, including a principal bedroom with dressing room and en suite bathroom. Two further bedrooms retain washbasins, and there is also a family bathroom. On the second floor are two rooms that could be turned into two bedrooms or a bedroom and a bathroom.

The gardens and grounds are a particular feature, comprising rolling lawns, meadowland and a variety of mature specimen trees, with extensive grazing pasture beyond, well suited to livestock. A substantial stone-built outbuilding provides garaging, storage and stabling, while additional parking is available within the gravelled courtyard.







Location

The property occupies a peaceful position in the small village of Brixton Deverill, approximately four miles from Warminster. The village has a parish church, while nearby Crockerton offers a pub and primary school. Warminster provides a comprehensive range of amenities, including a Waitrose, doctors' and dentists' surgeries, a library, golf course and the Athenaeum Theatre. The area is well regarded for schooling, with a strong selection of independent and grammar schools nearby, including Warminster School, Dauntsey's, Bryanston and Port Regis, together with grammar schools in Salisbury such as South Wilts Grammar School and Bishop Wordsworth's School. Transport connections are excellent. Warminster railway station offers services to Salisbury and Westbury, with onward links to London Waterloo and Paddington, while the A350 and A303 provide access to Bath, Salisbury and London
