The property

Little Braxted Mill House is a charming period property, occupying part of a former mill across the River Blackwater. The idyllic property offers flexible, light-filled accommodation and plenty of period character including exposed beams.

There are four beautifully presented reception rooms on the ground floor, including the semi open-plan reception and dining room with its ceiling and vertical timber beams and brick-built fireplaces. There is also a comfortable separate sitting room with a dual aspect, and a sunny, south-facing conservatory to the rear, which overlooks the stunning garden and river. The kitchen has farmhouse-style units, a butler sink and an Aga, as well as space for a breakfast table, while the adjoining utility room provides further storage space.

There are three double bedrooms on the first floor, plus a spacious landing area which can

be used as an additional reception room. The principal bedroom has its own dressing room with built-in storage, while the first floor also includes a study, a family bathroom and a shower room. The second floor provides a further three bedrooms, which could also be used as office space or additional reception rooms.

Outside

At the front, the house opens onto peaceful Little Braxted Lane and includes an area of lawn across the lane. There is a gravel parking area to the side of the house, which provides access to the double garage for further parking. The stunning southwest-facing rear garden provides a relaxing setting beside the mill stream, which flows gently past to re-join the River Blackwater a little further downstream. The garden also includes paved terracing for al fresco dining, immaculate lawns, colourful flowerbeds, established border hedgerow and several mature trees.

Location

Little Braxted is a small village on the edge of the town of Witham in the north of Essex. The village itself is a small collection of houses clustered around a small parish church and surrounded by the beautiful countryside of this rural part of Essex. Everyday amenities are close-at-hand in the bustling town of Witham, while there is excellent shopping and entertainment available at the nearby Freeport development in Braintree, or in the county town of Chelmsford. Witham also provides a choice of schooling, including the outstanding-rated Maltings Academy and several outstanding primary schools. Rail links to central London are excellent, with Witham providing regular services to London Liverpool Street (45 minutes). The area is also well-connected by road, with the A12 providing access towards Colchester, Chelmsford and the M25.

With Strutt & Parker's Chelmsford office on the left, head east on Rainsford Road, and take the first turning on the right onto Coval Lane. Turn left onto Parkway (A1060) and go straight ahead at two roundabouts to continue on Parkway. At the third roundabout, take the first exit onto Chelmer Road (A138), and continue straight ahead at two roundabouts, remaining on the A138. After just over two and a half miles following the A138, take the left lane and marge onto the A12 towards Colchester. Leave the A12 at junction 22 and then turn left onto Coleman's Bridge, passing back across the A12 and turning right onto Little Braxted Lane. You will find the property on the right-hand side after half a mile.
