# Old Station House Barney, North Norfolk

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## A charming period family house with private gardens situated in a highly sought-after location

Old Station House is a five bedroom period family house of red brick construction under a tiled roof, set over two storeys.





#### The property

The property is light and airy and comprises wellproportioned family-sized accommodation with generous reception rooms. Of particular note is the kitchen and breakfast room which leads out to the conservatory, which has splendid views over the rear private gardens. The first floor hosts four bedrooms, including the principal bedroom which is spacious and light and also benefits from views over the gardens.

#### Outside

The property is access via a private driveway with off street parking for several vehicles, with associated garaging. To the rear and side of the house are the gardens which are mainly laid to lawn with shrub and hedge borders.

#### Location

Barney is a quiet and secluded north Norfolk village which is well position for accessing the north Norfolk coast. Fakenham 6 miles to the west offers excellent local amenities including a Morrisons and Tesco supermarket and has superb schooling at Fakenham High School. Holt 7 miles to the north east is a historic Georgian market town which also offers excellent local amenities, boutique shops, restaurant and pubs and is renowned for Gresham' pre, prep and senior schools. Norwich the regional capital is located 25 miles to the south east also offers excellent schooling with Town close prep school, Norwich school and Norwich High School for girls. Norwich railway service ha regular links to London and Norwich International offers internation travel.
